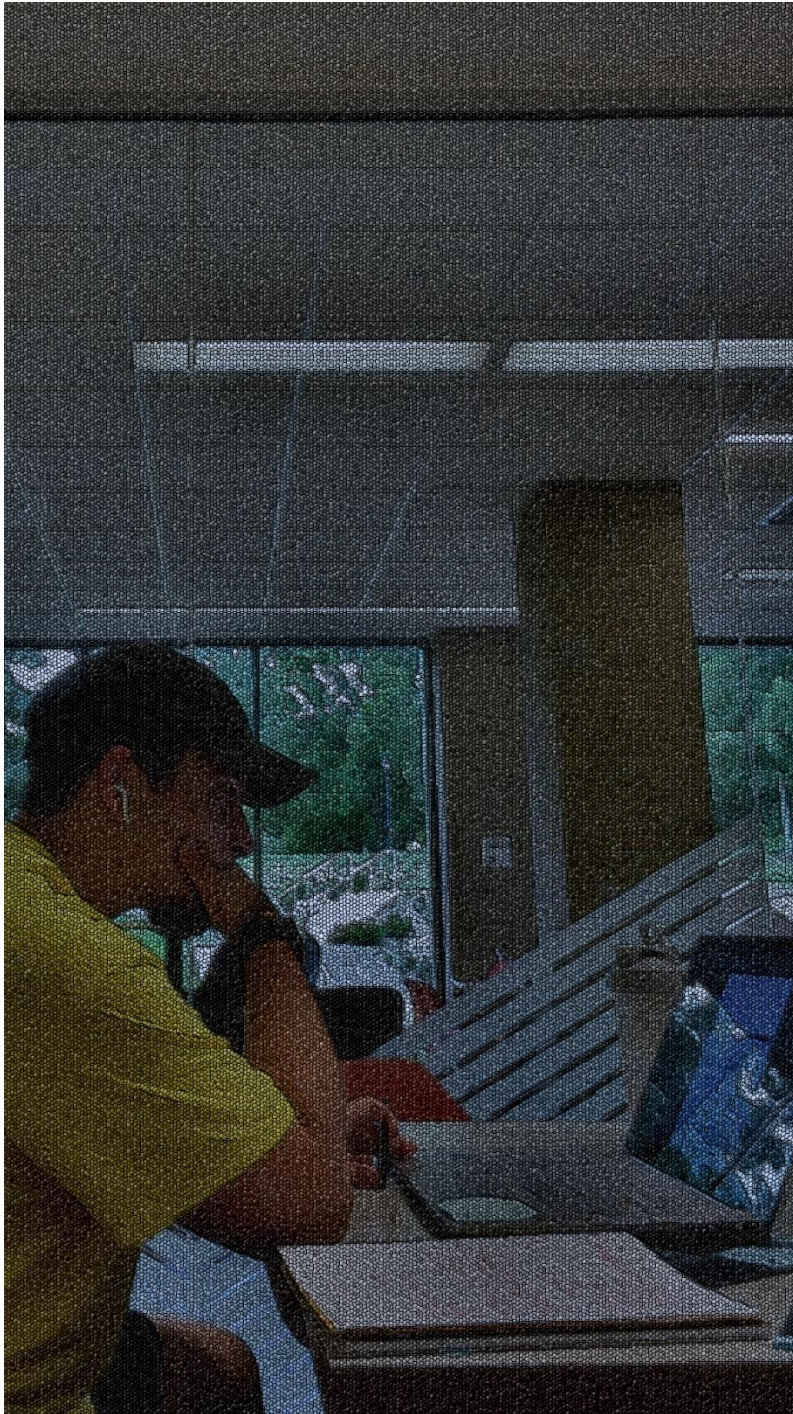


Photo One

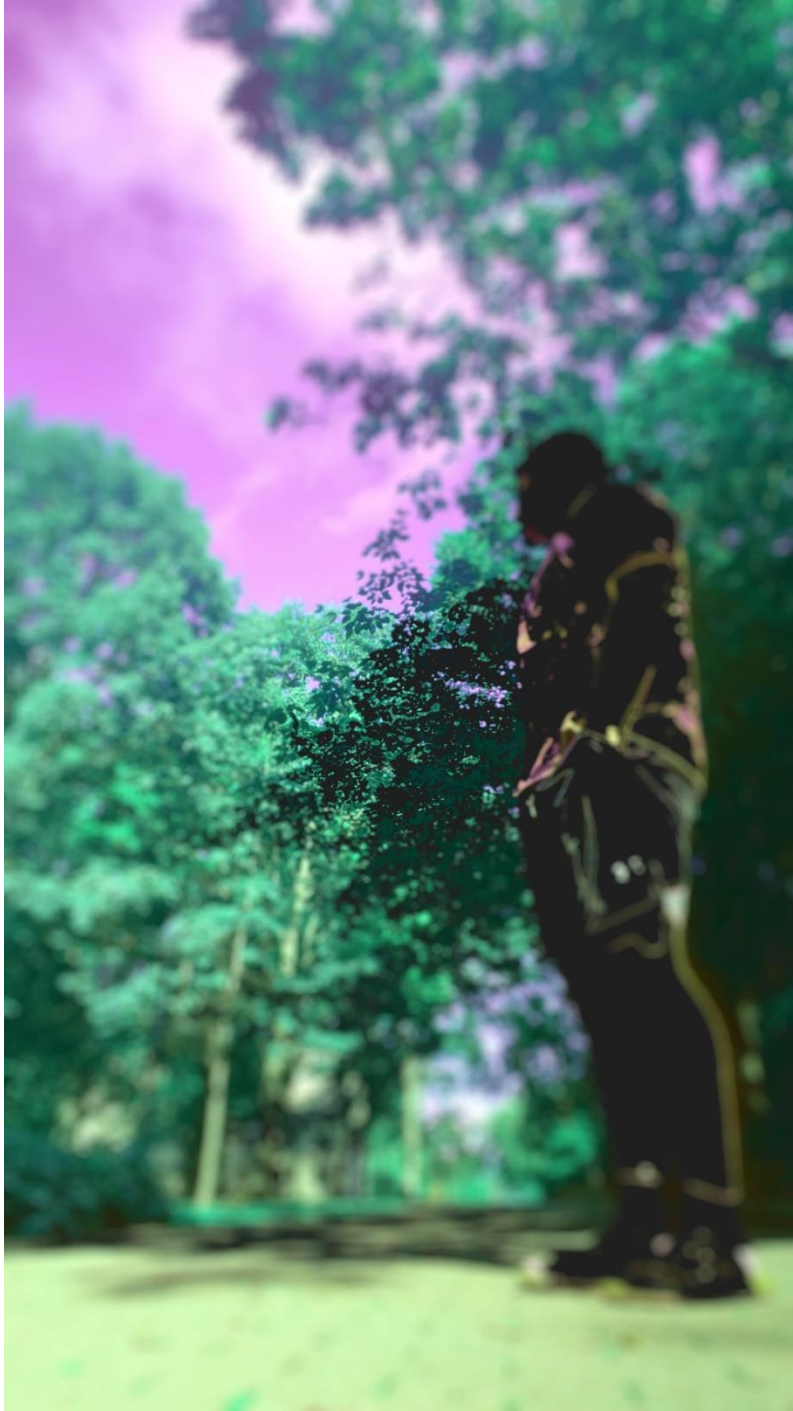
